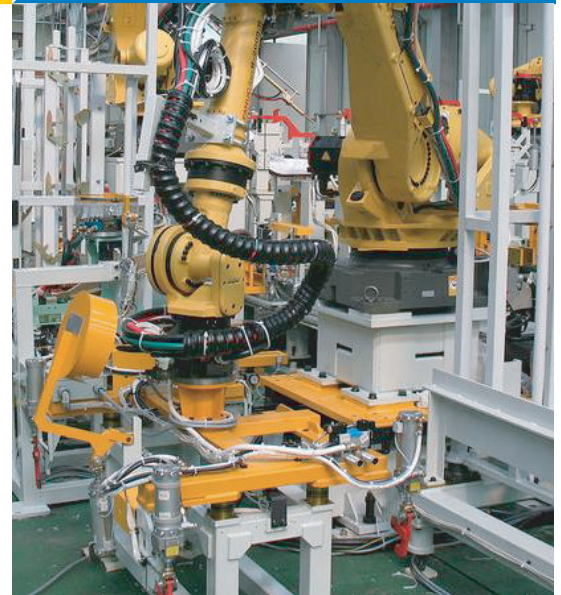
The Industrial Maintenance Mechanic program is an eight course, four-year program designed to prepare participants to work as skilled mechanics on electro-mechanical devices, installations, and equipment in an industrial environment.

Individuals who complete the apprenticeship program, which consists of eight courses and 8,000 hours of on-the-job training, are eligible to earn a Journeyman credential through the Delaware Department of Labor.
